This is what it's for

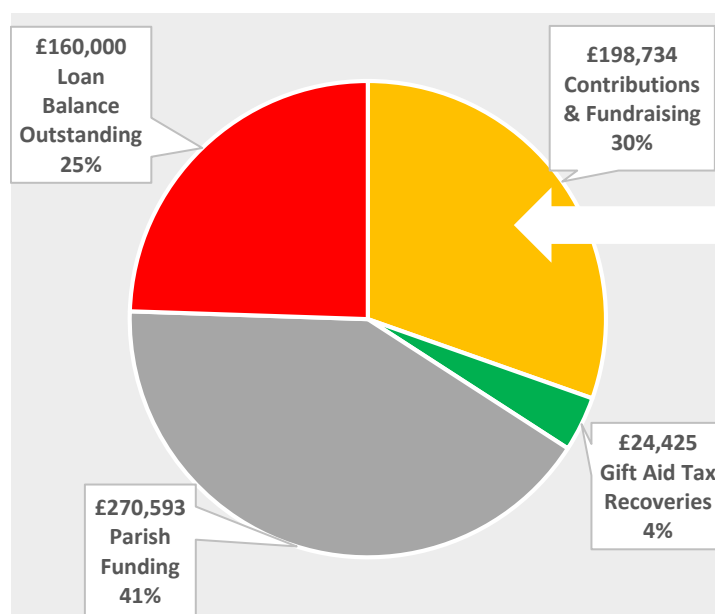
Monies raised for the Maintenance Fund are only spent on the repair and enhancement of the Parish buildings and site.
